16 Days of Activism against Gender Violence & December 6th Vigil

The 16 Days of Activism against Gender Violence Campaign is an international campaign starting November 25th until December 10th that focuses on gender violence and how everyone has a role in ending sexism and violence against women. Each day during the campaign the Status of Women Council NWT will be posting a new theme to do with gender violence or inequality and asking the community to like, share, watch or act in some way to help end gender inequality in the north. Some of the themes that we will be looking at are street harassment, men & feminism and victim blaming.

The December 6th Vigil also falls within the 16 days of activism where we will be asking Yellowknife residents to come out to Northern United at 4pm on December 6th for a remembrance and action vigil.
